This briefing is an opportunity for Maui to highlight local sustainability initiatives with members of Hawai'i Green Growth (HGG) and to learn about Maui's leadership role in statewide initiatives. HGG is a voluntary partnership of more than 50 state, county, federal, business and non-governmental leaders from clean energy, local food, natural resources, waste reduction, planning, green jobs, and other sectors, who are working together for a more resilient, sustainable and secure Hawai'i. HGG will present an overview of the *Aloha+ Challenge*, a shared statewide commitment to 2030 sustainability targets, and the Sustainability Measures Start-Up Project, which is developing statewide sustainability indicators to track progress on these targets.

A draft agenda is attached for your information. We hope that you can join us for this important, informative meeting to learn more about sustainability initiatives on Maui and across the state.
